Delivery Mode Code Description

INPER In Person meeting sections require attendance at a specific time and physical location for most or all activities.

SYNC - A course is considered Online Synchronous if online attendance is expected at a specific time for some or all course activities, and attendance at a specific location is not expected for any activities or exams. The timetable lists the course activity time which is synchronous in nature. Online synchronous courses with fewer than 6-hour/week scheduled activity will have online asynchronous component; please refer to the course outline for individual course offering details.

HYBR Hybrid meeting sections involve a mix of online and in-person interaction and require attendance at a specific time and physical location for some activities.

ASYN Online Asynchronous meeting sections do not require attendance at a specific time or location for any activities, with the exception of final or interim assessments, which may require attendance at a specific time and specific physical location.
