## **Enrolment in Outdoor Projects**

**ODP100H1** and **ODP200H1** enrolment will commence on ACORN starting at 6 a.m. on July 15, 2025. Registration will end on August 16, 2025, for both ODP100H1 and ODP200H1.

## **Third Year ODP Registration Procedures**

Enrolment in the third year ODP camps takes place via ACORN and follows a priority registration system. Year IV students receive priority for registration and will be permitted to add these courses on ACORN starting July 15, 2025, at 6 a.m. Year III students will be permitted to add these courses on ACORN starting July 22, 2025, at 12pm (noon). Waiting lists will not be active for the third year ODP courses.

## Medical, Diet and Emergency Contact Information (REQUIRED)

Once you have enrolled into the ODP course via ACORN and can find the ODP course shell on Quercus dashboard, check the announcements posted under the ODP course shells as students need to complete the mandatory medical, diet, and emergency contact information (via <u>Quercus</u>). You must submit and complete the required information via Quercus prior to joining the camp.

## **Detailed Course Information**

Outdoor project course outlines including camp descriptions, clothing and equipment lists will be available on the ODP <u>Quercus</u> course page prior to camp departure.

## **Cancellation & Refunds**

ODP course enrollments must be cancelled on ACORN by the published ancillary fee refund deadline for a full refund. Refer to the <u>Student Accounts website</u> for published refund deadlines. If you are unable to attend the camp because of illness or extenuating circumstances (documentation required), please contact <u>undergrad.kpe@utoronto.ca</u> to arrange for a refund. Camp fees cannot be transferred to a future outdoor project.
