POSITION SUMMARY:

The incumbent will be a member of the Sport & Rec Diversity & Equity team under the direction of the Assistant Manager, Co-curricular Diversity & Equity. Working closely with the Assistant Manager, and Physical Activity & Equity Intern, the incumbent will specifically assist with planning the SOAR Indigenous Youth Gathering - an outreach and recruitment program for Indigenous high school students for "March break" from Mar. 11th-16th, 2019. They will also assist with SOAR program budget tracking, liaise with SOAR program partners, assist hiring SOAR on-site coordinators and volunteers, and assist with on-site coordination of SOAR week programming. They will also assist planning and delivering cultural awareness orientation for SOAR on-site coordinator staff. A mid-term and final report with highlights, challenges, and recommendations will be due Jan. 25th, 2019 and Mar. 30th, 2019.
