Summary:	Reporting to the Manager, Tri-Campus Sports and supervised by the Coordinators, Tri-Campus Sport Operations & Administration, the incumbent will be responsible for the following:
	Convening Intramural Tournaments and Events. He/she will also be responsible to liaise with Intramural club representatives for tournament delivery.  Responsible for creating tournament schedules by sport and division as required.  Will need to attend entry meetings and supervise events as required. Will need to work with Intramural Head Referees and Game Manager Coordinators to ensure adequate staff personnel are assigned to events. Will work with ISC reps, captains, Recognized Campus Group/Club Executives and Intramural staff to promote tournament and events. Will need to keep IMLeagues up-to-date with all participant information.  Will complete a tournament/event report for each tournament/event with evaluation and suggestions for future activities. He/she is responsible for knowing and understanding emergency procedures and risk management principles that are relevant to the Intramural program, including being able to apply first aid to injured participants. He/she will be required to fill out

	injury/incident reports and deliver them to the appropriate locations in a timely manner.
	Will need to attend meetings with IM staff as required. He/she will act as a role model to all staff and participants of the Intramural program.  There may also be other duties as assigned.
Minimum	Education: Minimum of one year of post-secondary education completed.
Qualifications:	<b>Certifications:</b> In order to start employment, candidate must have current certification in (Standard First Aid certificate no more than 3 years prior to application date & Basic Rescuer/Level C CPR certificate no more than 1 year prior to application date) issued from Red Cross or Lifesaving Society or St. John's Ambulance.
	<b>Experience:</b> Preference given to those candidates that have Intramural experience. Experience with Intramural Tournaments and Events an asset.
