He/she is responsible for knowing and understanding emergency procedures and risk management principles that are relevant to the Intramural program. He/she is required to understand Intramural sport specific rules and regulations. He/she may be required to fill out incident reports and deliver them to the appropriate locations in a timely manner. He/she is responsible to ensure games start at the scheduled start times, where possible, this may be accomplished by working with the Intramural Game Managers and KPE Facility staff. There may also be other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:	Education: Prefer minimum of one-year of post-secondary education completed.
	Certifications: Preference will be given to those candidates that have current referee certification(s) within their respective sport(s).
	Experience: Prefer experience in the Intramural program. Individuals with experience officiating within a recognized sporting body will also be considered.
	Skills: This position requires positive communication skills, attention to detail, as well as the ability to mediate on field conflicts whenever possible.
