Summary:	<p>Reporting to the Manager, Tri-Campus Sports and supervised by the Coordinators, Tri-Campus Sport Operations & Administration, the incumbent will be responsible for the following:</p> <p>Scheduling referees/umpires within their respective sport in all divisions offered for that sport for all league/playoff games/matches and tournaments as required. This will be done through IMLeagues and other formats as necessary to maintain a listing of all scheduled staff. Must keep up-to-date on all IMLeagues schedules to be aware of game cancellations, rescheduled dates and other changes that may arise.</p> <p>Will need to maintain ongoing communication channels with IM referees and IM staff. Will be required to supervise staff from time to time and complete referee evaluations as needed. Is also required to provide ongoing constructive feedback to referees/umpires to help them improve and deliver a better experience to participants.</p> <p>He/she will act as a role model to all staff and participants of the Intramural program. Must be available to train staff in sport specific protocols and ensure those protocols are followed regularly. Will be required to attend regular meetings with IM staff, and provide reports when called upon. He/she is responsible for knowing and understanding emergency procedures and risk</p>

	<p>management principles that are relevant to the Intramural program, including being able to apply first aid to injured participants. He/she will be required to fill out injury/incident reports and deliver them to the appropriate locations in a timely manner.</p> <p>May be asked to attend additional training sessions as required.</p> <p>There may also be other duties as assigned.</p>
Minimum Qualifications:	<p>Education: Minimum of one year of post-secondary education completed.</p> <p>Certifications: Prefer candidate(s) have sport specific referee/official/umpire certifications/training.</p> <p>Prefer candidates that have (Standard First Aid certificate no more than 3 years prior to application date & Basic Rescuer/Level C CPR certificate no more than 1 year prior to application date) issued from Red Cross or Lifesaving Society or St. John's Ambulance.</p> <p>Experience: Must have a minimum of one term experience as an Intramural Referee, in the sport assigned.</p> <p>Skills: This position requires attention to detail, creative problem solving skills, positive communication skills, teamwork, flexibility and excellent time management skills.</p> <p>Other: Must provide a valid Social Insurance Number (SIN).</p> <p>Interviews will be held between May 13 and May 17; generally between the hours of 10:00am and 4:00pm. Further interviews may be conducted if position(s) remain vacant.</p> <p>*Note – Preference will be given to University of Toronto Students in the hiring process.</p>
